Seeking collaboration:

The academic session began with an Orientation Program which was conducted for the parents to help them decipher the School's policies, curriculum, pedagogy and protocols in accordance with the rules governed by the CBSE.

Hearty Welcome:

The Principal and the staff extended a warm welcome to the students to the new academic session 2023-2024, with new opportunities to grow, learn, and excel.

A special assembly was conducted by the students of Std. XII A. The assembly began with seeking the blessings of the supreme Power, the Almighty. An act was presented encapsulating the values and ethics for the students to follow. The students were guided to respect their principal, teachers, and seniors and to always be courteous towards everyone everywhere.

The Panel of Executives:
