

As I sit in my room, in front of the laptop, I ponder if what I'm doing is right, if my words have any power, and if all that is happening around me is as bad as we speak and discuss. I highly doubt the socio-cultural and political environment. Keeping quiet because one is apolitical and peaceful doesn't necessarily justify beating around the bushwhen you know something is wrong. Are we truly FREE? Or is it just a farce? And even if we are free, in what terms are we free? Since there is gender-biased dogmatism, lack of awareness, education, etc.

Even after seventy - seven years of liberation, there is raging violence and abuse performed against certain sections of the community. I may be biased but one can never heal burnt wounds engraved deep inside one's heart and mind. While it still pains me, I see women around who are not safe, constantly fighting to survive, when they should be able to live FREELY like the men in our society regularly do.

Misogyny is spreading so quickly and one may not be able to admit it openly, but closeted misogyny continues to exist. Is it the same India we aspired for when enslaved?
